#### **Registration for Show Floor Only**

#### **Registration for AWFS Educational Seminars**

### Verifying Teacher/Student Status to Receive Special Discount Rates

#### **FAX OR MAIL-IN REGISTRATION**

Teachers should enter the school's Tax Exempt Number, OR, attach a business card, a copy of their current staff ID or a letter from the school on letterhead for mail in registration, or include a copy of one of the above with a faxed registration. If a teacher wishes to register students, he/she must complete a separate registration form for each student and submit the forms with his/her registration. **You must complete one registration form for each individual. Do not enter multiple individuals on a single registration form.**

If a student wishes to register on their own, they must include a letter from their teacher/school on letterhead or submit a copy of their current student ID with their registration.

**NOTE:** Students and teachers who are finalists in the Fresh Wood competition do not need to submit a registration form as AWFS will register this group.

#### **ONSITE REGISTRATION**

Teachers must provide any of the following when registering onsite—school's tax exempt number, a business card or a letter from their school. Students must show a full-time student ID or a letter from a teacher or school on the school letterhead, unless they are in the company of the teacher at registration.
