## **Announces Exhibitor Space Draw Deadline**

CITY OF COMMERCE, Calif. – (April 17, 2012) The Association of Woodworking & Furnishings Suppliers<sup>®</sup> recently announced that the 2013 Fair will have an entirely new floor plan configuration as the machinery and supply halls, which have traditionally been located in the Central and North Halls respectively, will now be located into an expanded Central Hall.

"The new floor configuration should result in noticeably improved traffic flow as attendees no longer have to separate their time between halls that are located in two separate wings of the Las Vegas Convention Center." According to Angelo Gangone, Executive Vice President, AWFS. "In addition, although the show is being centralized, we are actually expanding the footprint of the Fair as we anticipate adding exhibitors for 2013, and returning exhibitors continuing to expand their booth space as the overall economy keeps improving and the industry continues to strengthen."
